P. Pronovost will call Allied Sanitation and have them move the containers into place.

P. Pronovost will find the next date for the training class for Transfer Station Attendants and get the operator scheduled to attend the class. Since the class is offered free by the State, S. Santa Maria stated he and several other members would like to attend the class.

E. Mone stated he has asked the existing committee's if they know of anyone interested in being a member of the Transfer Station Committee. R. Marcel was the original 5<sup>th</sup> member but has not been able to attend because of work commitments.

S.Santa Maria stated he will contact Sue Smith about procedures for buying the card reader and any other initial items required.

The Committee feels the permits will start being sold in January. Any permits sold in January will have a renewal date of Feb 1, 2010.

S. Santa Maria discussed the possibility of having the 1<sup>st</sup> year fee be 45.00 and subsequent years will be 25.00. This is to cover the high initial costs of the Transfer station modifications.

S Santa Maria is looking into the option of allowing credit cards to be used for payment at the Transfer Station.

The meeting ended at 5:30. No motion was made because a quorum was not present
