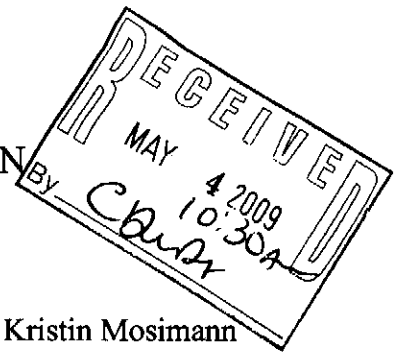


THOMASTON HISTORICAL COMMISSION  
April 28, 2009



Members Present: Joe Wassong, Cathy Russ, John St. Denis, Louanne Lauretano, Kristin Mosimann O'Sullivan, Lucille Killiany

Others Present: Scott Duff, Steve Iovanna and Fernanda Elves from BL Companies.

Joe called the meeting to order at 7:30.

Cathy made a motion, seconded by Kristin to move BL Company on the agenda. Motion passed unanimously. Steve Iovanna and Fernanda Elves presented two design option for both the unisex bathroom and the handicapped ramp and entrance.

Motion made by John, seconded by Kristin to request BL Companies to request an exemption for the unisex bathroom requirement. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion made by John, seconded by Kristin to accept Option A for the handicap ramp design and for BL Companies to proceed further with this option. Motion carries unanimously.

Motion made to approve corrected minutes of March 24, 2009 was made by Lucille, seconded by John. Motion passed 5-0-1 (Kristin abstained.)

Motion made by Joe, seconded by John to approved corrected minutes from April 1, 2009. Motion passes 6-0. Change spelling of Bob Madigiarz to Bob Magdiziarz.

Update on the boiler replacement project- John reported that 99% of the work is done. Joe is compiling paperwork that will be forwarded to the State for final reimbursement so that contractor will be paid.

- Office Doors- Robert White will do this project as well. Doors should be in soon.
- Cellar Sewer Line- Work completed by John Beecher, Bob Noack, and John St. Denis
- Other plumbing- New "guts" were installed in toilet by John Beecher.
- Painting- No updates
- Tasks to Open the House- We need a volunteer coordinator that will be able to begin rounding up volunteers and securing schedules for when the house is opened up next Spring.
- 2009-2010 Budget- Vote is scheduled for April 30<sup>th</sup>
